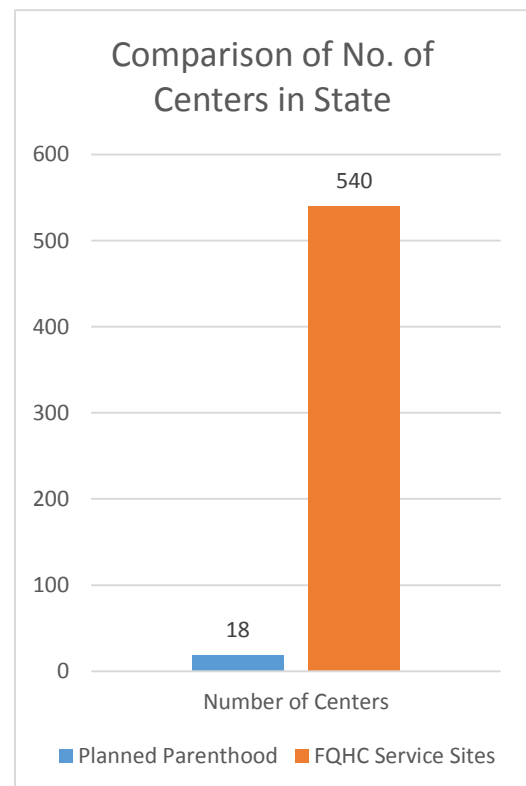


## Illinois: Comparison of Planned Parenthood and Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs)

While Planned Parenthood is the nation's largest abortion provider and performed 327,653 abortions in 2013,<sup>1</sup> federally qualified health centers (FQHCs),<sup>2</sup> which operate in service sites in both rural and urban locations, offer low-income populations health services similar to those provided by Planned Parenthood, but do not perform abortions.

- In **Illinois**, there are **42 FQHCs** operating in **540 service sites** and serving **1,153,336 individuals** per year.<sup>3</sup>
- In **Illinois**, there are 18 Planned Parenthood centers.<sup>4</sup>
- Nationwide, there are about **13 times the number of FQHC service sites** (9,170) than Planned Parenthood centers (about 700).
- Nationwide, FQHCs serve 21.1 million individuals per year, **nearly eight times more individuals** than are served by Planned Parenthood centers (2.8 million).<sup>5</sup>
